

# CAT candidates' details sought

**BANGALORE:** The Common Admission Test (CAT) 2009 is over for most of the candidates. However, it is important that candidates provide all details about their education to get calls for the group discussion and personal interview from the Indian Institutes of Management.

According to a statement, the last date to edit incomplete profiles is today (December 11). Candidates who have not completed their profile may login to the CAT IIM

website and do the needful. Meanwhile, Prometric has claimed that it was conducting a rigorous forensic analysis to ensure that every test result is valid and appropriate.

## Validation process

“Our work will not be done until our review of the situation is complete, the problems identified, and a plan is in place to ensure they do not recur. Every candidate has taken the CAT and all the results are validated.”

In a statement, Prometric

said it had been able to contact and reschedule exams for more than 17,000 affected candidates, the majority of who have since completed their test. It claimed that it was in the process of identifying candidates who may have experienced premature termination of the test, or were unable to test within the testing window.

“We will contact them to schedule a retake,” the company spokesperson said. The company has also apologised for the “less-than-satisfactory” test experience.
